A food bank is a non-profit, charitable organization that gives food to those who have difficulty buying enough food to avoid hunger. Six food banks in Taiwan launched an alliance in Taipei to share their resources and logistics more effectively and to push for lawmaking that encourages donations to food banks. The founding of the Cozy Food Bank Alliance in Taiwan is aimed at "No waste, no hunger."

Members of the alliance will share resources, information and logistics with each other, and cooperate in disaster relief assistance, community development and care services. They will also push for lawmaking that gives tax breaks for individuals and companies that donate to food banks, allows food banks or the public to purchase farmer's excess supplies at discounted prices to give to the needy, and better ensure the safety of the food being distributed.

Taiwan wastes 2.75 million tons of food each year, enough for 260,000 low-income households in Taiwan to eat for 20 years. A food bank gives surplus food to those who are too poor to buy enough food to feed themselves and their families. The first food bank was established in the United States in 1967. The Taiwan People's Food Bank Association became the 24th member of the U.S.-based Global FoodBanking Network in 2012.
